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<p><b>Key Skills – these are to keep the children ticking over (if you have time)</b></p>	
<p><b>Daily</b></p>	<p>Try hard to do 5-10 mins each day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tables Practise using games/websites/activities of your choice OR</li> <li>• Practise counting up and back in 25s and multiples of 25, e.g. 125s</li> </ul>
<p><b>Weekly</b></p> <p><i>Have a go at one of these each week if you have time/want some extra practice.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use Hit The Button to practise number bonds  <a href="https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button">https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button</a></li> <li>• Create a table to measure the length of different items around your household. Depending on the size use a ruler or tape measure. E.g. measure the table with a tape measure and measure a pencil using a ruler. Record your answers in your table. You could then compare some of the items using your subtraction skills.</li> </ul>
