Mon	3 mins TTRS Recap money: Use https://mathsbot.com/questionsIWB Set topic to 49. Adding coins, No of questions to 5 – difficulty level min 0, max 10 choose a set of star questions and record your answers in your book. Mark your answers. If you are super quick, increase the number of questions.
Tues	3 mins TTRS Money: Use https://mathsbot.com/questionsIWB Set topic to 50. Counting coins No of questions to 5 – difficulty level min 0, max 6 choose a set of star questions and record your answers in your book. Mark your answers.
Wed	3 mins TTRS Negative numbers: Use https://mathsbot.com/questionsIWB Set topic to 58. Negative numbers. No of questions to 5 – difficulty level min 0, max 6 choose a set of star questions and record your answers in your book. Mark when finished. If it was too easy, increase the difficulty level. Remember to think about where zero (0) sits in the number line and move in sections to and from 0.
Thurs	3 min TTRS Using Number Bonds: Use https://mathsbot.com/questionsIWB Set topic to 59. Number Bonds, No of questions to 5 – difficulty level min 0, max 6 choose a set of star questions and record your answers in your book. When finished mark your answers. If it was too easy, increase the difficulty level.
Fri	3 min TTRS Ordering numbers: Use https://mathsbot.com/questionsIWB Set topic to 60. Ordering numbers, No of questions to 5 – difficulty level min 0, max 7 choose a set of star questions and record your answers in your book. When finished mark your answers.
